

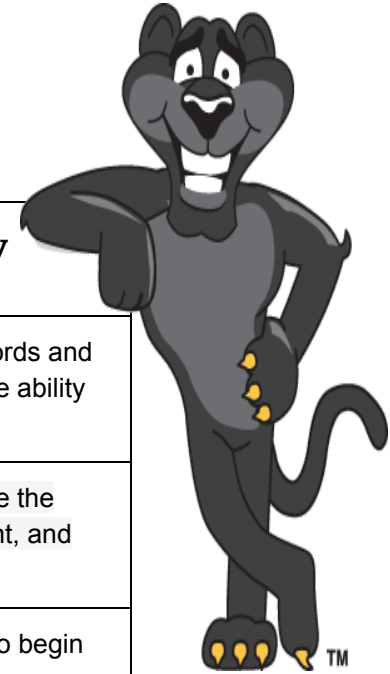

Language Arts	Students begin reading <u>Phineas L. MacGuire Gets Slimed!</u> Students will be able to discuss how characters' words and actions reveal a story's theme through a book talk on a book read independently. Students will demonstrate the ability to answer text-dependent questions about characters and theme.				
Social Studies	Students will be able to summarize the cause-and-effect relationship of the Columbian Exchange and Compare the various European settlements in North America in terms of economic activities, religious emphasis, government, and lifestyles.				
Math	Students will be able to identify prime and composite numbers as well as factors and multiples. Students will also begin to multiply two digit numbers by a one digit number using a variety of strategies. They will also be able to solve real-world problems using multiplication.				
Science	Students will demonstrate an understanding of the properties of light, that white light is made up of different colors.
