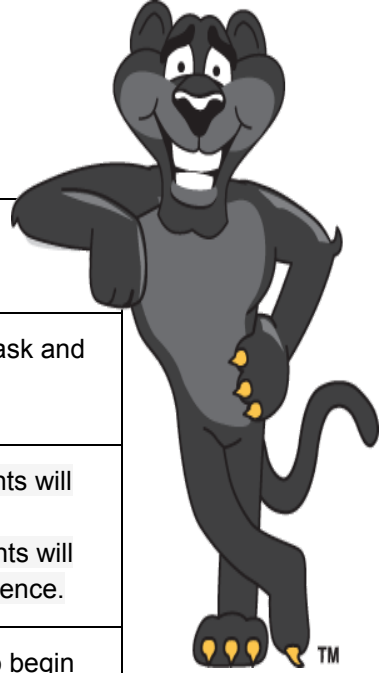

The following is a list of skills that your child will be learning during the upcoming week. This will enable you to keep up with your child's studies as the year progresses. Use this document to ask your child questions concerning the skills that are being addressed throughout the week.

Language Arts	Students will engage in and complete winter themed literacy activities. Students will participate in discussions; ask and respond to questions to acquire information concerning a topic, text, or issue.				
Social Studies	Students will demonstrate an understanding of the conflict between the American colonies and England. Students will summarize the importance of the key battles of the Revolutionary War and the reasons for American victories including Lexington and Concord, Bunker (Breed's) Hill, Charleston, Saratoga, Cowpens, and Yorktown. Students will explain the significance of major ideas and philosophies of government reflected in the Declaration of Independence.				
Math	Students will be able to identify prime and composite numbers as well as factors and multiples. Students will also begin to multiply two digit numbers by a one digit number using a variety of strategies. They will also be able to solve real-world problems using multiplication.				
Science	Students will demonstrate an understanding of the properties of light, that white light is made up of different colors.
